Installation Instructions

MyAHK.exe must be placed in a trusted location such as "C:\Program Files\". The executable will not run on until you install the digital certificate (Only needs to be done once):

- 1. Open the properties for the executable.
- 2. Click on the "Digital Signatures" tab.
- 3. Double-click the Signature.
- 4. Click on View Certificate and then click Install Certificate.
- 5. Choose "Current User" and follow the wizard to install it.
- 6. Choose "Place all certificates in the following store" and click **Browse**.
- 7. Select the "Trusted Root Certificate Authorities" and then click Okay.
- 8. Optional: Add a shortcut to your startup folder to start MyAHK automatically.

Updating

Steps to update to a new version of MyAHK.exe

- 1. Download the newest copy of MyAHK.exe.
- 2. Close MyAHK.exe (CTRL+ALT+BACKSPACE or end the process in Task Manager).
- 3. View the properties of the new MyAHK.exe and click Unblock if it is being blocked from running.
- 4. Copy the new MyAHK.exe over the old MyAHK.exe.
- 5. Once you run MyAHK.exe again you will be running the updated version.
